We want to try to do a few things to get you to think of eating with us during the week as well as on Friday night so here are a few things we are trying starting March 1. ### **NEW TIPPING POLICY REVISITED**

Our new tipping policy has been in effect now for a month and your Committee has heard positives from this change. There does still seem to be some confusion on how to make sure your bartender receives a tip if you did not bring cash for the Tip Jar on the bar or how not to tip twice on your drinks if you only have one bill for the night. You have a couple of options:

ut “real” money in the Tip Jar on the bar. When you get your total bill after dinner– in your mind calculate what you spent on alcohol –deduct it from the bill and tip on the residual amount. For example – Let’s say you get your bill for \$70 - \$50 is for food and \$20 was for alcohol. Since you tipped your

bartender at the bar – only tip the waiter on the food and service you received from that person - \$50. So in this case a 20% tip on a \$70 bill of which \$50 is food would be \$10.

on a separate bar tab and at the end of the night –add a tip to that bar bill. You will be presented with two bills then at the end of the night – one for alcohol and one for food. Be sure to tell your Bartender this is what you want to do. Tip accordingly for the food and service received.

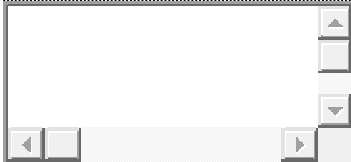


